1) Welcome and Apologies	<p>RW welcomed everyone to the September 2012 Steering Group Meeting at Lincolnshire Sports Partnership.</p> <p>Apologies were received from Cllr Doreen Stephenson, Cathrine Herrick, Gaynor Nash, Debbie Foote, Tracy Croft, James Turner, PC Jeremy Dodd, Phil Garner, Joanne Wright and Ian Reed.</p>	
2) Minutes of previous meeting 15.03.10	<p>It was agreed that the Minutes were accurate.</p> <p>RW read through each page to ensure that all actions not on the agenda for this meeting had been completed.</p> <p>EB provided a quick update on Inspire Mark and said that the East Midlands are celebrating our 100th Inspire Mark project next week, and are the second region outside of London to achieve this.</p> <p>JB commented that we should speak to the new facilities manager at East Lindsey District Council (ELDC) to discuss the possibility of using the Our Sporting Life Exhibition at the Lincolnshire Sports Awards. JB to follow up.</p> <p>HC commented that although there was no news from GN with Get Set, Yarborough School in Lincoln has set up a student 2012 Committee. <p>3) Lincolnshire 2012 Strategy Update</p>	<p>HC circulated copies of the proposed Lincolnshire 2012 Strategy Executive Summary to the group.</p> <p>SC commented that the photographs are just for an example and will be working with AD and JI to produce some Lincolnshire postcards i.e. a high jumper jumping over Lincoln Cathedral. JI mentioned that many of the well-known athletes from Lincolnshire are currently in Delhi at the Commonwealth Games and will not return until the end of October. SC, AD and JI to follow this up.</p> <p>CJ asked if the £120,000 funding secured for the Igniting Ambitions Lincolnshire Showcase 2011, and the Igniting Ambitions logo could be included in the Executive Summary. This was agreed. SC to amend leaflet.</p> <p>RW proposed that any feedback on the wording of the executive summary should be sent to SC by Friday 8th October 2010.</p> <p>SC proposed that any photographs for inclusion within the document should be sent to SC by Friday 16th October 2010.</p> <p>CJ and HC proposed replacing the bullet points of the charter with just the introduction and date it was signed, and use the space to include highlights and actions of what the Strategy will actually do for Lincolnshire. CJ and HC to liaise and forward information to SC.</p> <p>There was discussion about moving the Foreword or the Legacy paragraph to the middle third on the first page instead of the Key Actions for Events, as this currently sits out of place. SC to amend as appropriate.</p> <p>It was confirmed that the Strategy will be launched at the Sports Awards on 11th November 2010, at the Epic Centre. <p>5) Lincolnshire Day 2010</p>	<p>CJ said that the Cultural Strategy Launch is now taking place on Friday 1st October at 9am at Lincoln Castle, and the Opening of the Usher Gallery will take place in the evening.</p> <p>RW mentioned that Jonathan Platt at Lincolnshire County</p>

<p>Council was not aware of any sporting activities taking place for Lincolnshire Day. JI and CJ both commented that all the information around sport, including Sports Force, had been sent to the Lincolnshire Day Steering Group and website. It was agreed that there was a confusion of where to send things.</p> <p>CJ suggested that we add Lincolnshire Day to the agenda sooner, so we can arrange activities as part of the 2012 Steering Group, and promote them through Championing Lincolnshire. HC to action in 2011.</p> <p>SC said that the Business Convention Event at RAF Cranwell has 220 delegates attending, with guest speakers Richard Noble, Ian Whittle and Professor Paul Stewart.</p> <p>RW said that no funding has yet been secured for a volunteer week around Lincolnshire Day, but this will hopefully be found soon. JI commented that when the funding comes in, the Young Peoples Conference that was supposed to run on Lincolnshire Day can be organised.</p>	HC
<p>6) Cultural Solutions Update</p> <p>Cultural Solutions team; David Lambert, Sara Bullimore and Tim Harris provided the group with a presentation and update about the Igniting Ambitions Lincolnshire Showcase 2011.</p> <p>The team explained that the 2011 Showcase will take place from 1 May 2011 – 31 October 2011.</p> <p>The £120,000 funding secured for the project will fund 12 projects (from 43 applications), providing they get their match funding by the end of the year.</p> <p>The 12 projects are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Unlocking the City – University of Lincoln - Sa Fire Festival – Arts NK / NKDC - Dark Metal – National Trust - Moving Colour – ELDC / SO Festival 2011 - Riverside Olympiad Festival – Riverside Association of Music and Arts Programme - Knit2gether – Carol Parker - The Charter of the Forest – The Collection - The Labours; And Astronomical Dance - BEAM! International Festival – Lincoln BIG - First Light on Tour – Martin Griffiths - Junk Sculpture – Sound LINC - Trivia of Eccentric England <p>DL commented that 7 of 12 will be running from 1st May – 31 October 2011, throughout all of Lincolnshire.</p>

RW are still looking are more funding opportunities, and are looking to get V-Base (a volunteer database) up and running. <p>8) AOB</p>	<p><u>Sports Policy Sub-Group: Lincolnshire 2012 Legacy</u></p> <p>Jl informed the group that a Lincolnshire 2012 Sports Legacy group has been set up at Lincolnshire Sports Partnership. The group will specifically focus on sport and physical activity in Lincolnshire as a result of the Games, after it was felt that everyone was waiting for a steer from Sport England. It was decided that the group will focus on four specific areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Volunteering - Signposting - Facilities - Links between schools and clubs <p>Jl will feedback to the Steering Group.</p> <p><u>Lincolnshire Sports Partnership AGM</u></p> <p>Jl informed the group that as part of the Lincolnshire Sports Partnership AGM, LSP are hoping to also talk about the Olympic Legacy and Olympic events within Lincolnshire.</p> <p><u>Active People Survey</u></p> <p>Jl informed the group that after speaking to Mark Homer at Lincolnshire County Council, it was suggested that we organise a celebration day in January 2011 to promote the 1% increase on our Active People Survey results which prove that more people in Lincolnshire are taking part in sport.</p> <p>Jl suggested promoting this as an Olympic Celebration Day, branded with Championing Lincolnshire, to promote the Active People survey, but also the Igniting Ambition Showcase and</p>	<p>Jl</p>
